



P1AR Flight Paramedic/Helicopter Rescue Specialist

Priority 1 Air Rescue's Paramedics function as the most extensively trained primary care provider in the pre-hospital setting. The paramedic job description is to be responsible for all aspects of care provided to the sick and injured. The paramedic provides both basic and advanced life support, including comprehensive patient assessment, invasive airway management, cardiac monitoring, and administration of medications. All Paramedics are qualified as Rescue Specialists and can be hoisted in and out of the helicopter to provide pre-hospital medical treatment to the patient. All P1AR Paramedics are State certified and National Registered Emergency Medical Technician – Paramedic and trained and tested to perform medical practices while in flight in an Air Medical/Air Rescue Helicopter.

- Minimum of three (3) years of experience in a busy 911 system within the past five (5) years.
- National Registered Paramedic (NRP)
- Current certifications in Healthcare Provider BLS/CPR; ACLS, PALS, PHTLS & NRP
- Acquire State Certification based on Operational Base Location(s)
- It is preferable for the candidate to have prior experience working as a Flight Paramedic.
- Preferred military or civilian Helicopter Search and Rescue (SAR) experience
- Flight Paramedic Certification (FP-C) preferred
- Physically fit (must pass pre-entry physical appropriate to safely conduct relevant duties)
